Know your member id

Your member id is key to the information “behind the curtain” at the Member Center portion of the web site. But if you don’t remember it, click the “member ID lookup” link.

Enter some simple information

All you need to know is your name and zip codes as stored in the Association’s Records

Confirm your selection

Click the radio button on the left and the “Next” at the bottom right.



<p>1. What's New. Check here for important announcements</p>	
<p>2. Search Find almost anything you need with this search. Be sure you're using the Google search box!</p>	
<p>3. Member Center Access Much of the “premium content” and much news is available here</p>	
<p>4. Main menus Note that there are two horizontal menus across the top of the page.</p>	

We estimate that 90% of your visits to www.aauw.org will start by clicking one of the areas noted above – remember the key links are across the top and in the upper left.

If you don't know how what you need will be “filed”, use the search. Other wise use the menus or start at the Member Center.
